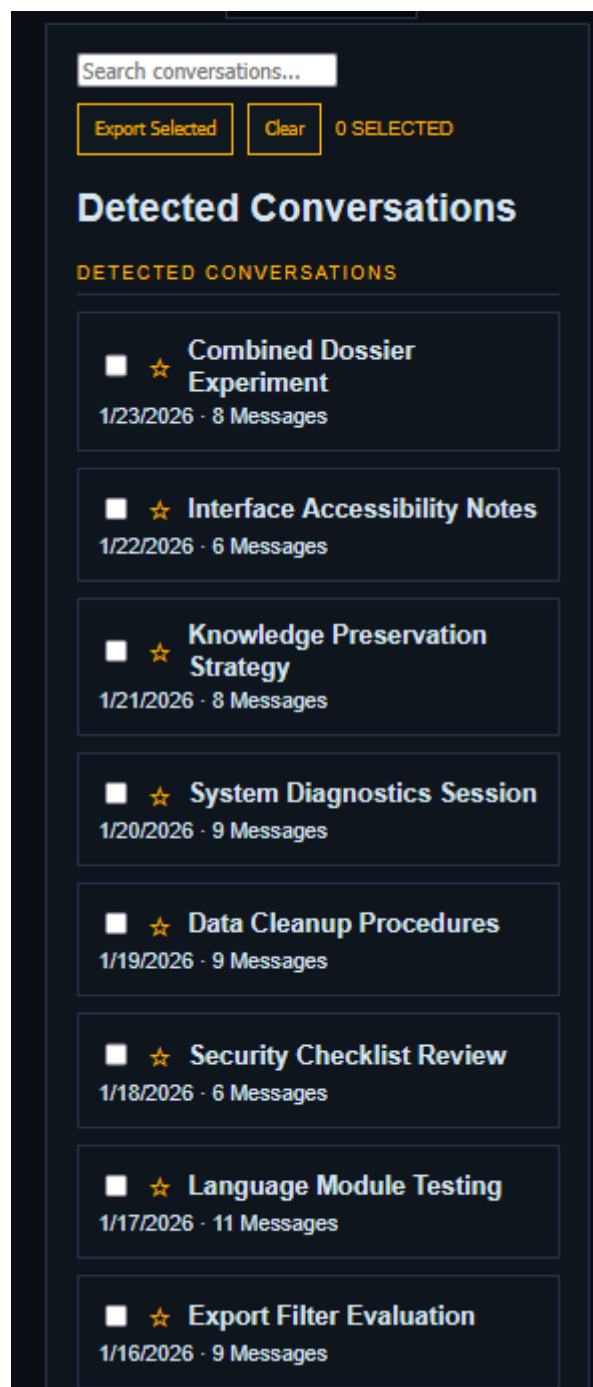

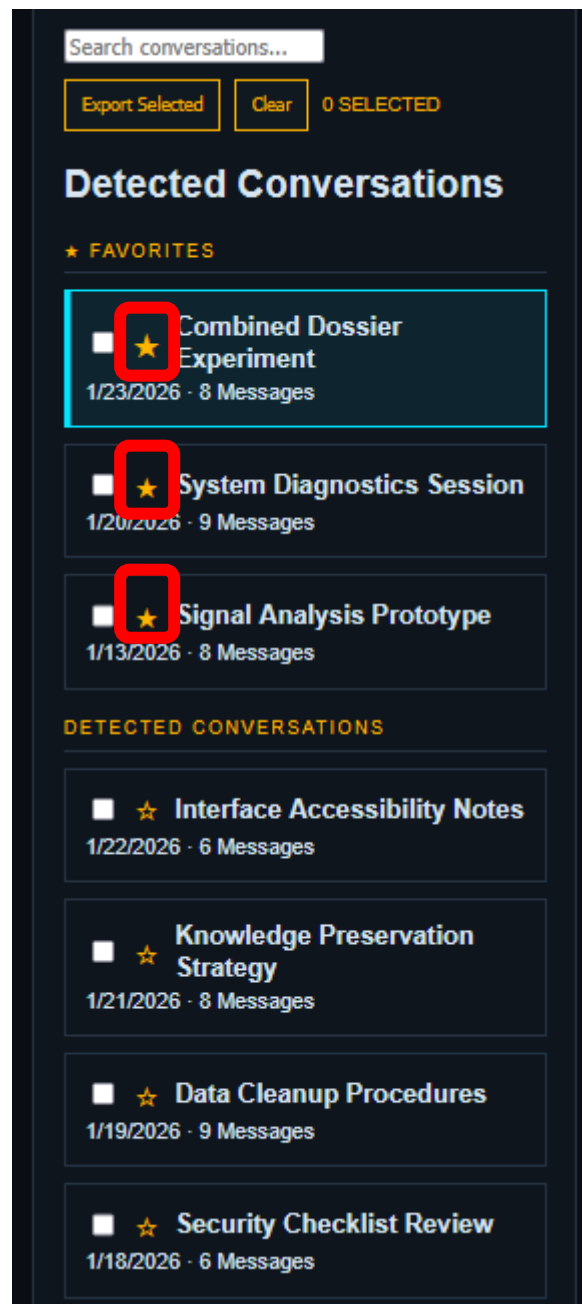
1.3 Favorites

2. Settings



2.1 Archive Commander Settings

The Settings Panel allows operators to customize the behavior, appearance, and export format of the Archive Commander.

2.2 Interface Theme

The Interface Theme controls the appearance of the Archive Commander itself.
